

Kellie Lisi was attending the Fund for Leaders banquet with her husband when she heard ELCA Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton speak about a new path for leaders called to diaconal ministry. Deacons serve across the ELCA in congregations, college campuses, hospitals and specialized ministries for disability, education and music.

As soon as Kellie heard about the work of deacons, she knew she was meant to do it — the Holy Spirit reached Kellie through Bishop Eaton that day. Kellie enrolled in seminary the following year with the support of ELCA donors. For the past several years, Kellie has served as director of community life and candidacy at Wartburg Theological Seminary, where she finds great joy in guiding the next generation of leaders in the ELCA.
